The targets were set to be five fast and furious stages, with the target sequence mimicking this year's SASS Michigan State Championship match.

When the dust settled, and the scores were announced **Sinola Kid** was the top competitor followed by **Riverview Rattler** and **Shelby Kid**. Top women competitor was **Diabla** followed by **Longshot Lillian**.

On Sunday, July 28, 2024, DSC hosted a 5 stage Wild Bunch match. # Know the Difference Between Heat Exhaustion and Heat Stroke

**Heat Exhaustion** 

# Symptoms

- headache
- · dizzy or fainting
- · heavy sweating
- cold, pale and clammy skin
- nausea or vomiting
- · fast, weak pulse
- · weakness or muscle cramps
- excessive thirst

### What to do

- Hydrate with water or sports drinks. No alcohol.
- · Move to a cooler, air-conditioned place.
- · Lie down.
- · If fully conscious, sip water.
- Take a cool shower or use cold compresses.
- If vomiting continues, seek medical attention.
- Act quickly. Untreated heat exhaustion can progress to heat stroke.
- · Remove tight fitting clothing or extra layers

Heat Stroke - Medical Emergency



# Symptoms

- · headache
- confusion or delirium
- · may lose consciousness
- no sweating/dry skin
- hot, red skin
- · nausea or vomiting
- · rapid heart rate
- body temperature above 104° F

### What to do

- Call 911. This is a medical emergency.
- · Move the person to a cooler place.
- Use cold compresses to reduce body temperature.
- Do not give fluids
